Good Afternoon

Term 6 is always a very busy term and so please keep a check on the diary dates as dates are being added very week – new dates are always highlighted in yellow.

Y1/2 had a great day out on the Romney, Hythe and Dymchurch Railway this week, learning lots about the local area. Its been a week of tests and quizes for most of the school this week, as teachers check children's attainment and progress for this year for their reports which will be handed out on 12<sup>th</sup> July.

Y5 parents, must not forget that registration for the Kent test (PESE) and the Shepway Test is open. They can apply online and on either Folkestone School for Girls or the Harvey Grammar School website. The Shepway Grammar School Test will take place on **Saturday 14<sup>th</sup> September**. The Dover Grammar Schools Test will take place on **Saturday 14<sup>th</sup> September**. The Harvey Grammar will be holding their Open Evening for Year 5 pupils and their parents/carers on **Tuesday 2<sup>nd</sup> July from 6.15pm – 8.30pm**. This is an opportunity for boys and their parents/carers to visit the school and to see first-hand what life at The Harvey is all about and to consider applying for a place in their Year 7 intake for September 2025. We now also have the date for the Brockhill Park School Open Day for Y5. It will be held on **Thursday 11th July from 5.00 -8.00pm**.

Pray for good weather as its Sports Day on Wednesday  $26^{th}$  June. The BBC website says it's going to be fine at the moment - high temperatures of 21 degrees. YR, One and Two will race from 9am until 10.15am. Y3/4 from 10.30am until 12.00 noon and Y5/6 from 1.30pm until 2.30pm. Everyone is welcome to come along and support the children. Mr Donald has made a plea that all children have suitable PE kit in school – it does not have to be in official school colours but shorts and a t-Shirt with either trainers or plimsolls.
