Y5 parents, don't forget that registration for the Kent Test (PESE) and the Shepway Tests open this week. You can apply online at www.kent.gov.uk/kenttest and on either Folkestone School for Girls or the Harvey Grammar School websites.

The Dover Grammar Schools Test will take place on Saturday 14th September. There is a meeting for parents that will be held at Dover Grammar school for Boys at 5.00pm on 26th June. Dover Girls Grammar School has also planned an open evening on Tuesday 11th June from 6.00pm until 8.00pm. Parents can also tour the school and see classes in action on Wednesday and Thursday 12th and 13th June – you will need to call the school to book an appointment to be included in these tours.
